ATKT rules for the students seeking admission to 3rd/5th semester in the undergraduate programme from the academic year 2020-21 onwards.

ATKT Examinations and rules

ATKT examination is for those students who have either failed in previous semester subjects but are Allowed To Keep Terms. Also students who got dropped in the previous semesters can appear during these exams.

The rules for ATKT are as follows:

Undergraduate (aided/unaided)

- 1. Students from odd semesters (Semester 1, 3, 5) are automatically promoted to the next semester irrespective of the number of backlogs.
- 2. A learner will be allowed to keep terms for semester 3
- if the learner has passed semester 1 and 2 in full

OR

- for programmes with 900 marks or more, the learner has failed in not more than 600 marks in both the semesters taken together and for programmes with less than 900 marks the learner has failed in not more than 400 marks in both the semesters taken together.
- 3. A learner will be allowed to keep terms for semester 5
- if the learner has passed all courses in semester 1, 2, 3 and 4.

OR

• for programmes with 900 marks or more, the learner has failed in not more than 600 marks in the previous four semesters taken together and for programmes with less than 900 marks the learner has failed in not more than 400 marks in the previous four terms taken together.
