	It was observed by Dr. Soniya Shetty that most students did not have			







	sufficient knowledge about the topics taught at S.Y.B.Sc. class in Course II in Semester VI. The primary reason for this was that there no semester end exams due to the sudden lockdown. Hence, students had not studied these topics. An understanding of concepts in these topics was necessary for them to study biochemistry in T.Y.B.Sc. Students were asked to select topics of their choice from any of the three modules in Course II and make a presentation on the same. Every student made a presentation in front of the entire class. For one session students of S.Y.B.Sc. were also invited to attend the presentations.  Students used tools like powerpoint presentations, videos, animation tools like Renderforest for their presentations. 65% students were making a presentation for the first time. 65% strongly agreed and 25% agreed that this activity helped to develop their presentation skills. 60% strongly agreed and 25% agreed that it helped to build their confidence of speaking in front of an audience.  More than 86% students said that it helped them to understand the subject better and wanted to participate in more such activities.  This activity not just enhanced their subject knowledge but also helped their develop soft skills required for presentations from using various tools for preparing presentation to language and communication skills.

Expected Outcome	Students would be able to recollect and revise topics in biochemistry studied in SYBSc and be able to understand TYBSc topics in a better way. Also, soft skills in presentation would be enhanced.
