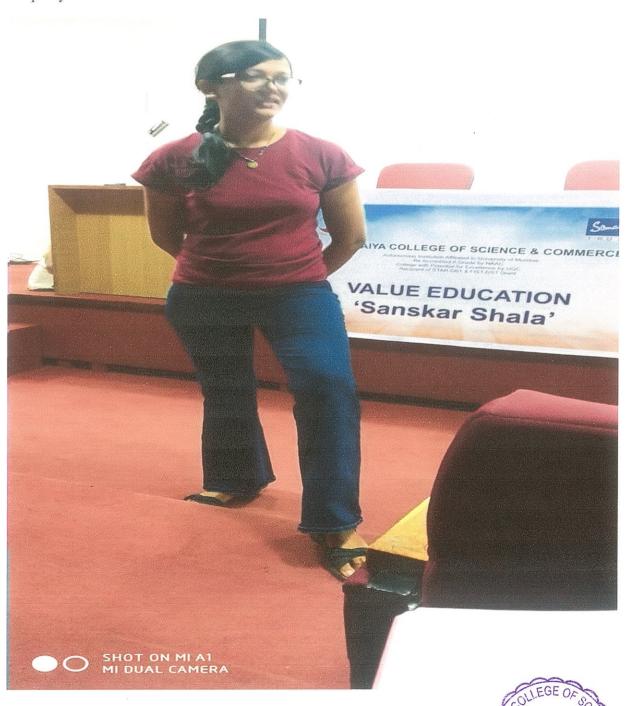






Session 3:

#Values Dr Shashikant













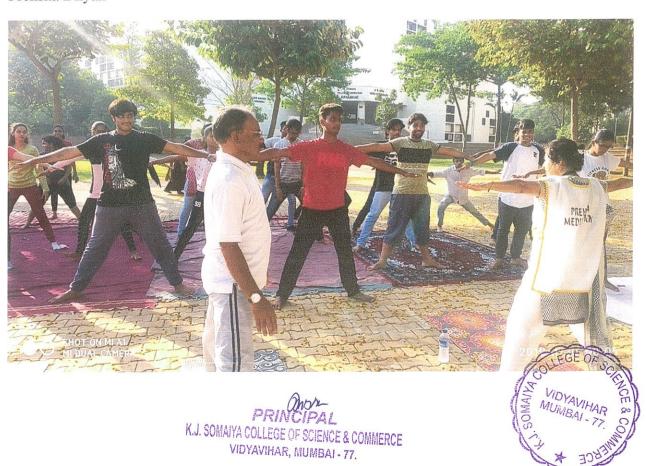

Session 7: Eduga

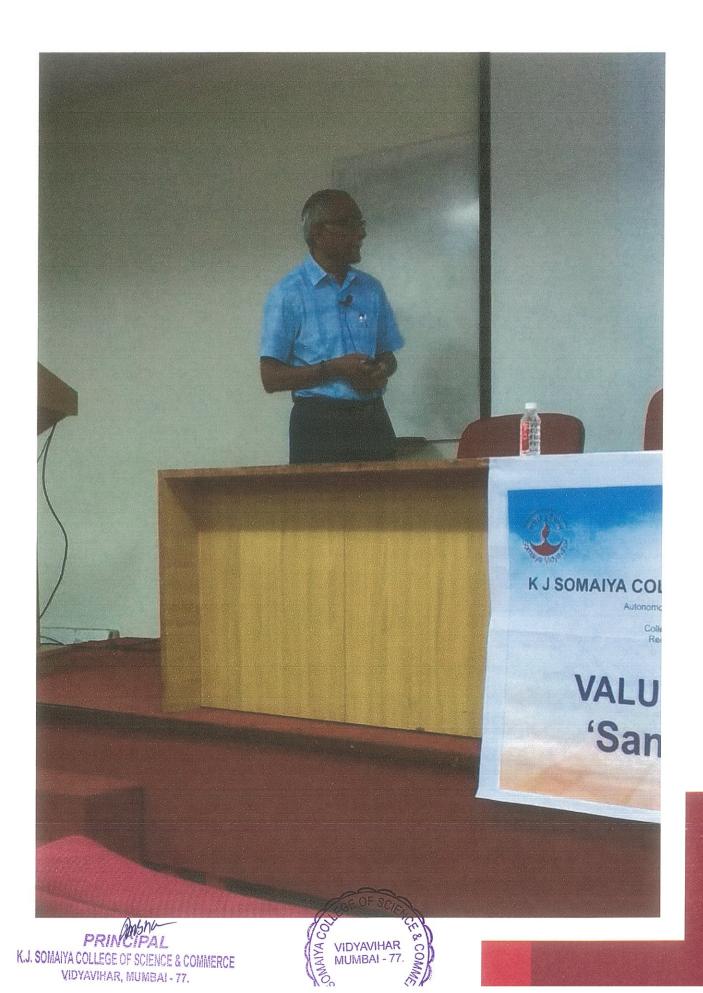

Hearfulness Meditation.

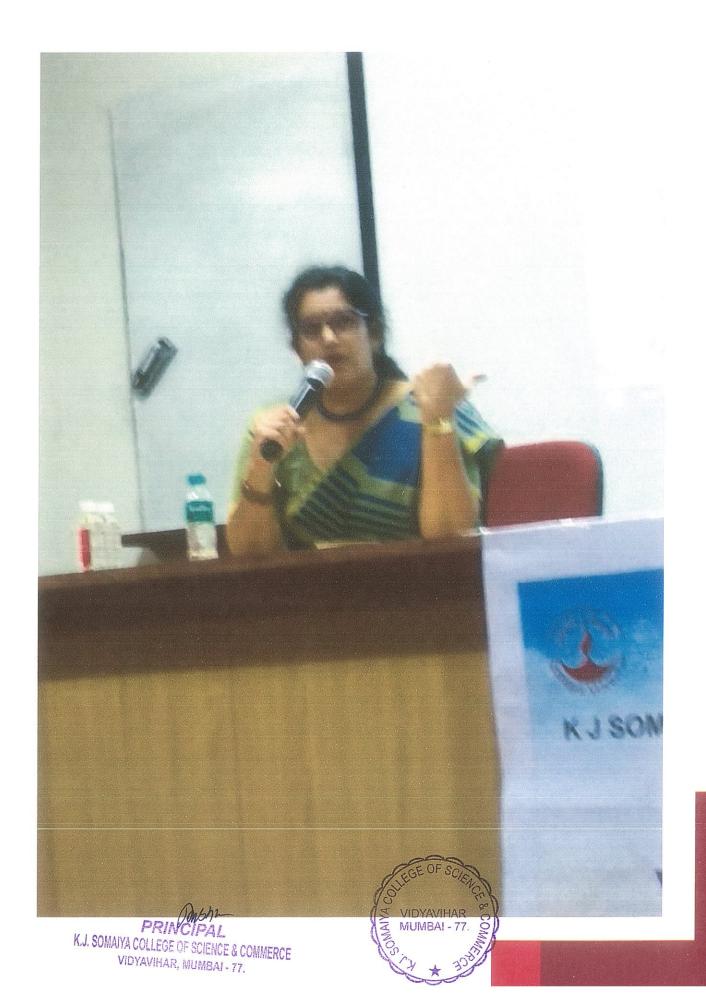

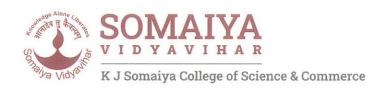

To give an example of a deep friendship she ended with multiple day to day examples in few shayaris.



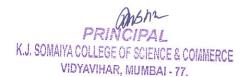












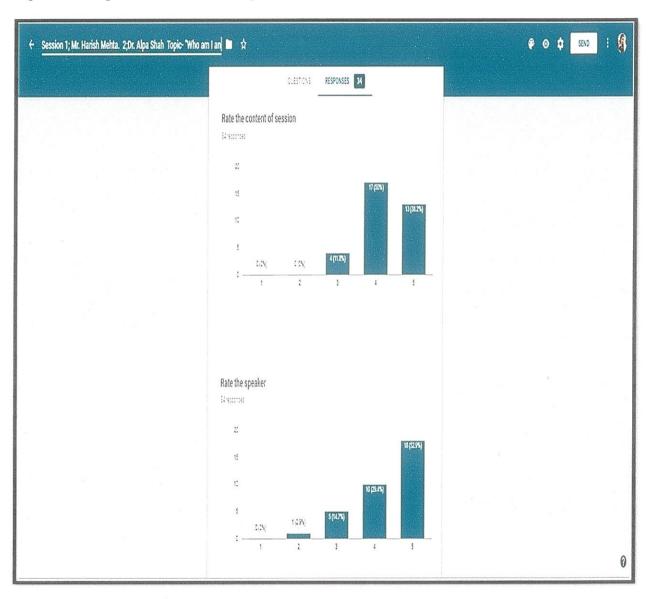

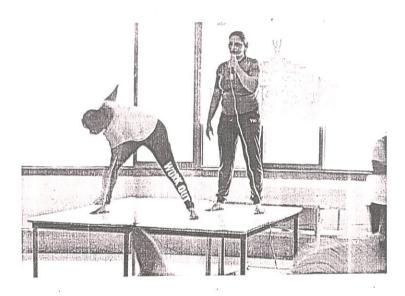




# REPORT INTERNATIONAL YOGA DAY

International Yoga Day was celebrated in our college on 21st June,2018 in which many activities were taken place with immense support of teaching, non-teaching staff and students.

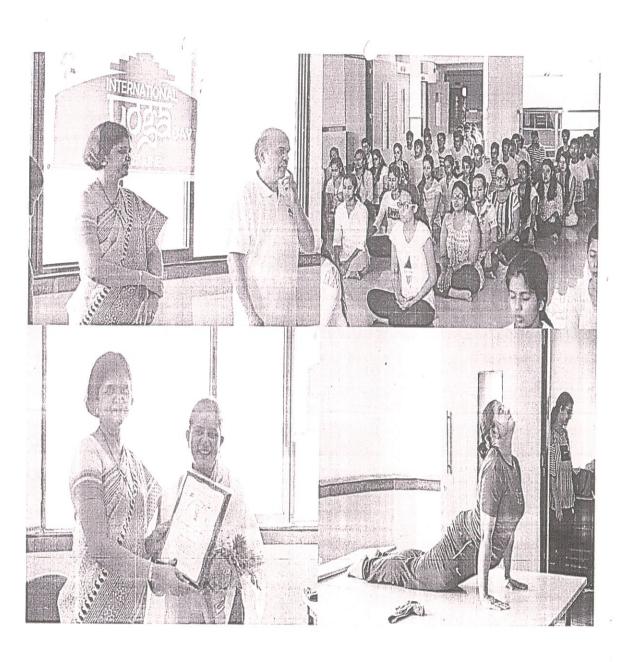
